Overell, 62 and his wife Beulah, 57 were aboard their 47 foot Yacht, the Mary E, which was moored in the harbor, when an explosion aboard shattered the still of the night while many of the residents were either in bed asleep or about to go to bed and sent the yacht to the bottom of the shallow harbor. The Explosion was heard by Newport Beach police officers Lawrence Goddard and George W. Calihan who were on patrol in the area. They saw the boat sinking and called the fire department. The two officers saw Bud and Louise running hand in hand near Bay Avenue and A Street. The boat was boarded at 11:52 P.M. by Robert Myers of the Newport Beach Fire Department and he found the bodies of Walter and Beulah Overell. Members of the Coast Guard arrived shortly and took the bodies to the Baltz Mortuary. At this point, murder was not..
